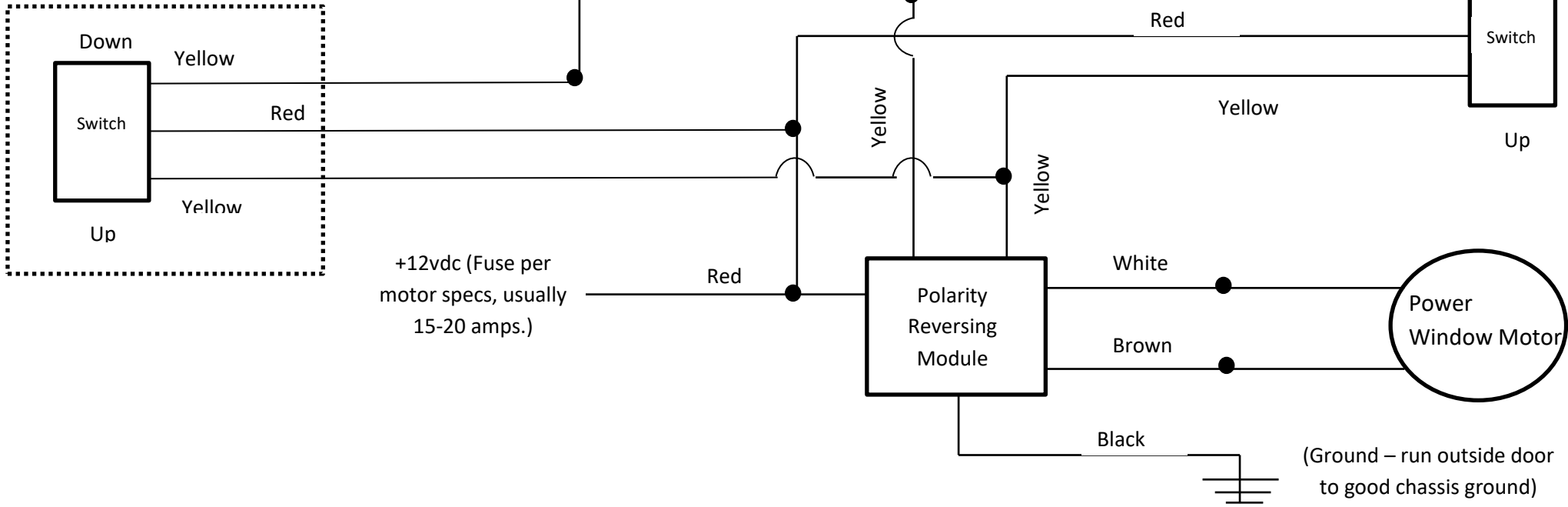

- 1. Determine the Location** for the switches in your door or console. Switches mount on top of panel. This requires that you wire switches as a last step. Make sure you leave ample wire for panel removal. See sketches.
- 2. Cut Switch Holes** using the template/ dimensions carefully mark and cut holes.
- 3. Do the Wiring.** Follow Diagram On Page 2.
- 4. Reconnect the main power and test your wiring**
